# HOW TO PLAY

# 1

Start by shuffling the deck, then pass out three cards to each of the players. Make sure that you always have three cards in your hand.

## 2

Players take turns acting out one card at a time. Success is judge by whether you attempted the action or not. Everyone has a different comfort level, so just try your best.

### 3

If you successfully complete an action place it in a separate pile.

The player with the most cards at the end wins the game!

## **Bring a Friend**

This symbol represents the recommended amount of players required to complete a card.

When the turn is over, the person who drew the card gets it.



## **Timer**

This symbol represents the amount of turns that a player must act out a card in order to successfully complete it.



## **Star Power**

Congratulations! These cards are special. Use them wisely as they can give you an advantage.

# SPECIAL CARDS



Skip your turn. Keep this card, it's a free point.



Turn any card into a player vs. player challenge, choose a judge. The person who wins the challenge gets both of these cards.

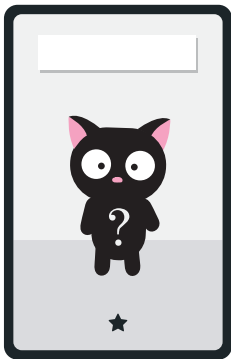


Give one of your cards
